Fusako "Seiga" Hoyrup was born in 1938 in Japan.

She holds the Shukan Degree in Ikebana, which is the highest achievement level in the Wafu School of Ikebana. Fusako studied Ikebana under the personal direction of the late Wafu School Headmaster, Wafu Teshigahara.

She and her husband relocated from Japan to Cupertino, California, in 1969. In September 1969, she founded and established "The Art of Ikebana" classes in the San Jose Unified School District.

These classes were the "first of its kind" in the Bay Area.

Hoyrup has been the Founder and President of Wafu School of Ikebana, California Chapter from 1970 to present.

Fusako has shared her life-long passion for the art of Ikebana extensively throughout the state of California and internationally in Johannesburg, South Africa, Denmark, Sydney, Australia, Brazil and Tokyo.

In 1996 she performed at St. Petersburg Chapter, Florida.
