Chieko Soei Mihori is a Sogetsu Ikebana School Instructor and holds the highest rank in the Sogetsu School of Riji.

Born in Tokyo, Japan, Mrs. Mihori has been teaching Ikebana for the last 62 years in the United States. She studied with the founder of the Sogetsu School, Sofu Teshigahara and has studied under all the subsequent Sogetsu headmasters.

Mrs. Mihori is the Director of the Sogetsu Florida Branch and Coordinator of Sogetsu North America, East Coast. She presents Ikebana demonstrations and workshops throughout the United States and abroad.

In addition to teaching flower arranging, Mrs. Mihori is an instructor in the *Omete Senke* School of tea ceremony.

Mrs. Mihori and her husband were instrumental in the founding of the Morikami & Japanese Gardens Museum in Delray Beach, Florida. She was a Trustee and Board Member and served as the Vice President for Cultural Affairs for the Morikami Museum

and continues to be a key member in its continued growth and success. For many decades, she demonstrated and gave classes in Ikebana, Tea Ceremony and Kabuki Dance at the Morikami Museum.
